

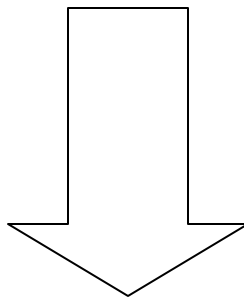


SUGGESTIONS IN PREPARATION
FOR PRESENTING
BECOMING A MODERN DAY PRINCESS
TO YOUR CHURCH

You have caught the vision and now you desire to implement "**Becoming a Modern Day Princess**" in your church. There are some necessary appointments and meetings that must be made enabling you to impart this vision God has given you for your church or group.

The first and most important step in preparation for your presentations is to PRAY.

- a. Pray for God's favor with the leadership you will be meeting with.
- b. Pray for the girls' hearts to be open to attend the class.
- c. Pray for the parents' cooperation as the girls ask them to participate in various parts of the 10-session study.
- d. Pray for the parents and others from your church who will assist in the "**Night of Celebration.**"



Meeting with the Youth Pastor

Key points as to why you want them on board with you:

- ❖ They will be assisting you in igniting the spark in the hearts of the young girls in your church to take the class. (Showing the video, passing out flyers re: parents' meeting, etc.)
- ❖ They usually have a rapport with the parents of these girls. Ask if they would be willing to write a letter recommending the class to the parents. Or, ask permission to use their name and their recommendation in the letter you will write to the parents.
- ❖ If this individual is a man, let him know that he may be called upon by a girl attending the class to be the man to pronounce a blessing upon her, if she should not have a godly father or other godly man in her life.
- ❖ This individual will potentially be the person that will give the message regarding "Imparting a Blessing" at the "Night of Celebration."
 - a. Share why you have a passion to see this happen in your church.
 - b. Have the leader's guide and girl's notebook journal available for their review.
 - c. Make the recommendation that to start this off in your church it would be beneficial in offering this to all girls from 8th-12th grade who would like to participate in the inception of what can become a tradition within your church. Thereafter it would be for 8th grade girls.
 - d. Ask if they would be willing to promote this at Youth Group by showing the video and distributing flyers for the Daughter/Parent Meeting.

Present to them that after the video is shown, you would like permission to have an address and telephone list of all the girls from 8th-12th grade with the purpose of notifying them of the first Daughter/Parent meeting.

Communicating with the Youth

- a. With the cooperation of your Youth Pastor, ask to attend their Youth night a few times prior to the class so the girls can get to know you personally.
- b. Send out a personal invitation to each girl and a separate letter to her parents regarding the Daughter/Parent meeting.

Communicating with the Parents (Daughter/Parent meeting Sample Agenda)

Have copies of the following available for each parent:

- Session Outline for Prospective Parents'
 - "Request for Help" form
 - Instructions for "Imparting a Blessing"
- a. Start the meeting with prayer.
 - b. Share your vision for your church.
 - c. Show the video.
 - d. Let there be a time for comments and questions.
 - e. Review the Session Outline for Prospective Parents'. Emphasize the importance of their participation in Weeks 1, 2, 3 and 7.
 - f. Present the "How to Impart a Blessing" form and inform them that a meeting for the parents will be held about the fifth week of the study in preparation for the Night of Celebration.
 - g. Present the "Request for Help" form for the Night of Celebration.
 - h. Ask them to return the form to you by the second parents meeting.
 - i. Close in Prayer.
